Special TROCAIRE collection

The Irish Bishops Conference has asked parishes to hold a special Church collection on Saturday the

6th and Sunday the 7th of November to support Trócaire's response to a humanitarian crisis in East Africa.

In the absence of second collections during Mass, there will be a basket in front of the altar for both Masses next weekend.

Indulgences

In November, you can take advantage of two indulgences. First, from 12 noon on 1 November until midnight on 2 November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions can gain a plenary indulgence for one soul in Purgatory by visiting a church or oratory, and there recite one Our Father and the Apostles Creed.

Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 November to 8 November.

Second, anyone who visits a cemetery and prays for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual condition once per day from 1 to 8 November.
