REFLECTION

The cross is today the universal image of Christian belief. Countless generations of artists have turned it into a thing of beauty to be carried in procession or worn as jewelry. To the eyes of the first Christians, it had no beauty. It stood outside too many city walls, decorated only with decaying corpses, as a threat to anyone who defied Rome's authority—including the heretic sect which refused sacrifice to Roman gods and spoke of the cross as the instrument of salvation,

Pope Benedict XVI in his homily on the Holy Cross at the Shrine of Lourdes said: "What a great thing it is to possess the Cross." Then quoting St Andrew of Crete, the Pope said that he who possesses it possesses a treasure.

Today the Gospel reminds us of the meaning of this great mystery: God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that the human race might be saved.
