POINTERS FOR PRAYER

John gives an example of humility as a person confident in his own role but not seeking to claim to be more than he is. He is able to acknowledge that Jesus is greater. There is a freedom in being able to acknowledge the gifts of others without losing a sense of one's own giftedness.

Bring to mind memories of experiences in which you knew you were the beloved (of God or of another person) and that the one who loved you was well pleased.
