Novena for the Holy Souls

Starts on Mon 2nd November and ends on Tue 10th. Mass Monday to Friday, at 9.00 am and 8.00 pm and Saturday 10.00 am as well as the scheduled Vigil and Sunday Masses.

Envelopes are available in the sacristy now for distribution. The 8.00 pm Novena Mass on Fri next, Nov 6th, will be commemorating those who died during the past 12 months and praying for bereaved families.

Confessions for Holy Souls Novena

Sat 31st Oct: After 8.00 pm Mass
Sun 1st Nov: After 10.30 Mass
Before and after evening Masses during the Novena.

2nd November – Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

From 12 o'clock noon on Sun 1st November until midnight on Mon

2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.

This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st November to 8th November.

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this
