## JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY The Six Precepts of the Church

Since ancient times, people who hear the successors of Peter and the apostles preaching Christ instinctively ask, What shall we do? In our own day, the core responses to this question are summed up in what have come to be known as "The Precepts of the Church."

Catholics should consult the Precepts of the Church as a sort of "self-assessment" by which their compliance with the minimum criteria for active Church membership can be measured.

- 1. Attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation, and rest from servile labour.
- 2. Confess your sins at least once a year.
- 3. Receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.
- 4. Observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
- 5. Help provide for the needs of the Church.
- 6. Observe the Church's laws on marriage.
