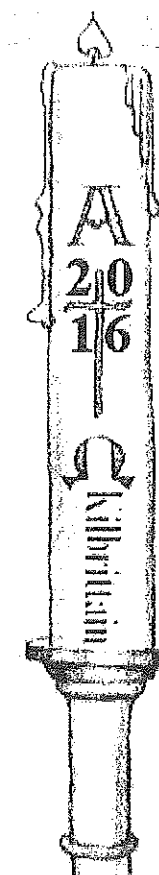
INDUCTION LOOP

Within the last few weeks an induction loop and transmitting technology have been installed in St Patrick's Church. This system responds to a special setting (marked 'T') in most hearing aids. The loop transmits the sound electromagnetically and the hearing aid tunes into this signal, giving a clearer reception than picking up the analogue sound from the church speakers. Please remember to set your hearing aid selector to the 'T' position. I'd be pleased to hear any comments, favourable or not, from users.
