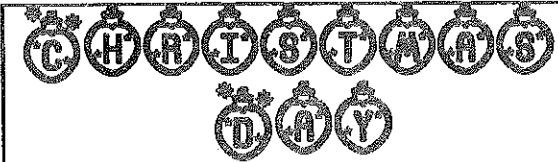

Kilbrittain GAA would like to wish all parishioners a safe and happy Christmas.



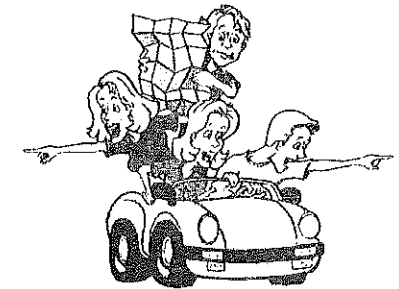
Lotto 1 - 19 - 25 - 29
