# Amazing Grace

Amazing grace! How sweet the sound That saved a wretch like me! I once was lost, but now am found; Was blind, but now I see.

'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, And grace my fears relieved; How precious did that grace appear The hour I first believed.

Through many dangers, toils and snares, I have already come: 'Tis grace hath brought me safe thus far, And grace will lead me home.

"Amazing Grace" was written by the English poet and Anglican clergyman John Newton (1725-1807) in 1779. He wrote the words from personal experience. He grew up without any particular religious conviction and became involved in the Atlantic slave trade. In 1748, a violent storm battered his vessel off the coast of County Donegal so severely that he called out to God for mercy, a moment that marked his spiritual conversion. He continued his slave trading career until 1754 or 1755, when he ended his seafaring altogether and began studying Christian theology.
