## Bandon Cluster of Parishes Experimental Summer Schedule

Bandon, Kilbrittain, Newcestown and Enniskeane priests will be operating a new schedule FOR JULY AND AUGUST ONLY in order to give each priest a break during the summer. Each parish, except Kilbrittain, will be dropping one weekend Mass to bring the total Masses in the cluster down to ten. Rotas have been drawn up to enable these Masses to be covered by four priests, leaving the fifth priest free for the weekend on a rotating basis. This means that all five priests will be celebrating a weekend Mass in Kilbrittain at one time or other and that Fr Cremin will be rotating through the six churches in the cluster, ie Kilbrittain, Bandon, Gaggin, Newcestown. Farnivane and Enniskeane.

Masses booked for anniversaries, etc will be said as scheduled the the priest on duty.
