Voice Ireland is an environmental charity that empowers individuals and local communities to take positive action to conserve our natural resources. Together with Repak, The Dept of Communications and The Dept of Climate Action and Environment have launched a programme of Presentations/Workshops to help people improve Ireland's recycling rates and reduce levels of contaminants in household recycling bins. Up to 30% of what goes into the domestic recycling bin is not suitable or is contaminated. The presentation takes approximately 30 minutes and the message is simple. "What goes into the recycling bin and what doesn't". After the presentation there will be a question and answer session. This is a free workshop and everybody is welcome.
