### OUR NEW VOTIVE SHRINES

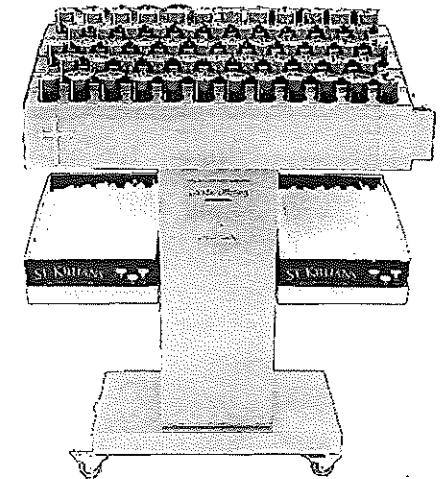
On trial until Easter. Smokeless candles that when burned down drop into a reservoir of water for safety. The system St Killians operate is that the Shrines, which cost almost €1,000 each, are given to us free of charge (permanent loan) and cleaned and maintained by them on a

monthly basis. What they gain from us is that we buy the little cone-shaped candles, which burn for about two hours, at the rather high price of 19c each.

The units are quite attractive and fit in well with the fresh and clean appearance of our beautifully-kept church.

If by Easter or so people find that there is no great difference from the electric shrines, we can return the whole lot and get refunded for any unsold candles. Indeed, since we won't own the shrines, this option is open to us at any time.

We have set the the offering at 30c per candle in order for the church to benefit from a modest profit of 11c per candle, bearing in mind that the electric shrines used to cost nothing to run, so that every cent which went into the slots was kept by the parish.
