Commemoration of those who have died during the last year.

We encourage family members to take their labelled candle home at their convenience after the end of the Novena as a reminder of the Masses offered and the privilege of praying for the Soul of the Faithful Departed.

Indulgences

There is no restriction on the distance one may travel in order to visit graves of loved ones. Many people will be anxious to take full advantage of this concession to compensate for not being able to attend Mass and receive Holy Communion during the Novenas. Because of special circumstances

this year, the Indulgence for each daily visit to a cemetery is not confined the first eight days of the month but extends to every day up to Nov 30th. The faithful who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and* prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) and who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th for all of November. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. ***The stipulation for Holy Communion has to be set aside and the 'Act of Contrition' will suffice instead of Confession.**
