Indulgences

Because of special circumstances this year, the Indulgence for each daily visit to a cemetery is not confined the first eight days of the month but extends to every day up to Nov 30th. The faithful who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and* prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer

of one's choice) and who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th for all of November. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. *The stipulation for Holy Communion has to be set aside and the 'Act of Contrition' will suffice instead of Confession.

Christmas Arrangements ??????

We can only speculate at this stage what will be possible for Christmas liturgies. The only certainty is that we are going to be very short of options. Bishop Gavin has been sharing some musings and hopes by email this week. Parish Assembly would welcome your thoughts on any aspect of the situation and hope to be able to meet under eased restrictions to come up with some solutions.

Some thoughts from the bishop

We already know that even a 'best case scenario' where we can have pods of 50 with social distancing will still only allow for very limited numbers.

Christmas Masses

It will be necessary to have Christmas Masses spread over a number of days. One suggestion is to use the 12 days of Christmas. Serious consideration should be given to a ticket system for Christmas Masses which could be a combination of booking online and people coming to the church or parish office for those who do not use internet. This would avoid disappointment, large crowds and enable us to offer alternative possibilities.

Sacrament of Confession

With regard to the Sacrament of Confession it may be possible to do a combination of socially distanced individual Confessions in the open church with a screen or outdoors. This could happen during Advent. These arrangements could be complimented with an online communal celebration of a personal 'Act of Contrition' with the resolve of going to individual Confession when it is possible to do so in the future.
