To my sorrow, my ideas -- and the were my own ideas totally -- for multiple Masses on Chistmas Eve and Christmas Day have proved unfeasable. Bookings are vastly exceeding my estimates to the extent that, after allocating 500 places, we have in excess of 150 applications we cannot cater for and requests are still coming in.

There is no question of scheduling extra Masses, we'd need at least three more just for the current level of applications. The only way, I think, to treat everybody equally is to have our Christmas Masses online ONLY. I will stream a Mass for Christmas Night and another for Christmas day. There will be a huge choice of other Masses online and on television. Also, the church will be open all day Christmas Eve and Chistmas Day for individual visits.
