ONLINE DONATIONS

Kilbrittain has completed the process for facilitating online donations, in accordance with the bishop's recommendation and following the initiative of other parishes.

The 'Donate' button shown below now appears on every page of the 'kilbrittain.org' website. It opens a

page through which you can make donations with credit or debit card. It will have options for people to sign up as registered contributors or to give a once off donation, anonymously or otherwise, by using the 'guest' option.

Signing up as a donor, with email address and your chosen password, means that any subsequent donations won't require repeated input of Credit/Debit Card details, etc.

The system is run by Payzone. Our 'donate' button only passes you over to Payzone and they handle every other part of the transaction: they accept Credit Card details, collect the donation, pass on the money to the bank, issue you with an email receipt and compile a complete report for us. This means that all security measures are implemented by Payzone, who have long-standing practice and reputation in handling online payments.

Options which are available or which will go online within a few days are:
Weekly Offertory Contribution which, if one is signed up, can be once-off, automatically paid every week or month. Can also be paid as once-off or manually on separate occasions without being signed up.

Priest's Income. As above, with automatic periodic repetition as an option and not obligatory to have signed up if once-off.

Diocesan Quarterly Collections. All as above.

There is also the possibility of adding in future: Mass offerings; Trocaire Donations; any or all the monthly special collections; special campaigns like the appeal used some years ago to fund the new steps; Vincent de Paul; any other church cause or appeal usually collected by the church for passing on to other charities.

Also available to parishes for future expansion is payment by card-tap and mobile phone through QR Code and electronic terminals.

Cost. Payzone and bank retain a small percentage of each donation, that is the way Payzone makes a living. The parish will absorb this, though the system allows us to let you tick a box to add the collection cost to the sum donated. We won't implement this option in the foreseeable future. An example given by Payzone of collection cost is that the total shared between Payzone and bank on a donation of €10 would be 33 cent.
