Easing of Restrictions

From this Monday, 6th Sept, churches are allowed to have congregations equal to half their seating capacity. This gives the go-ahead for First Holy Communions and Confirmations, it removes the numeric restriction for weddings and funerals and replaces it with a more flexible limit depending on size of church and abolishes the zone system within churches.

Here in Kilbrittain our half-capacity is about 120, excluding galleries. With proper distancing and mask-wearing we are probably back to facilitating normal pre-covid congregations, given that we still have three Masses instead of two. (But Sunday Mass attendance hasn't been made obligatory yet). Townland Rotas will still be published but I'm only asking people to consider keeping to their

own Mass as an act of Community charity and only if it is in no way inconvenient.

If intentions for more widespread easing during September and October are allowed to come to fruition, I intend to return to the normal programme of two weekend Mases, without Townland zoning, at the start of November. Livestreaming of weekday Masses and one weekend Mass will be the norm permanently.

If all goes well, from November 1st we will go back to normal Saturday and Sunday Mass times. Incidentally, I am considering setting the Saturday Vigil Mass time at 7.00 pm in Winter time and 8.00 pm in Summer time. This plan appears to have received approval from the few with whom I have discussed it, but I'd like to hear wider reactions.

To mark the occasion and to give thanks to God and his Blessed Mother for the graces bestowed on the Legion and its members, there will be Mass and Legion prayers here in Kilbrittain at 7.00 pm that evening. Mass will be preceded at 6.45 pm by the recitation of the Most Holy Rosary and the Legion Prayers will be recited within the Mass. Everybody is welcome. Mass (but not Rosary) will be livestreamed.
