### Priests' Meeting

From Sun week, 14th Nov to Thurs 18th every priest in the Diocese is required to attend a Gathering in Killarney. As was the case with the recent Retreat, there will be no weekday Masses on those days and emergency cover will be arranged by the Dioceses.

### Special TROCAIRE collection

The Irish Bishops Conference has asked parishes to hold a special Church collection on Saturday the 6th and Sunday the 7th of November to support Trócaire's response to a humanitarian crisis in East Africa.

*In the absence of second collections during Mass, there will be a basket in front of the altar for both Masses this weekend.*

### Indulgences

Don't forget the special privilege we have this year which extends the indulgence for visiting a cemetery to EVERY DAY in November, and not just the first week.

### Confession Box

We have an excellent Confession box in Kilbrittain church but I have been avoiding using it for a long time now in favour of less satisfactory options because of the crush of chairs and seats in front of it. These make it harder to get in and out and give the illusion at least of reduced privacy. The solution I'd desire and have communicated to the Parish Assembly involves removing two or three seats from the end of that side of the women's aisle. This should create a 'buffer zone' in front of the box that would be kept strictly empty at all times except that it could

double as a wheelchair area when necessary. I am seeking opinions on this idea because I know it would entail a disturbance for some people and a certain loss of convenience to many.

### Disabled Parking

The two designated disabled parking slots outside the porch have been repainted. This is part of an arrangement between parish and school which has been sanctioned by the Diocese. The passage from the car park going behind the sanctuary has been designated as wheelchair access for the lower school buildings, hence the widening of the access opposite the sacristy door and the new tarmac. There will also be two more disabled parking spaces marked out at the school end of the car park. (These would be available to all churchgoers at weekends and on other days when there is no school.) All this work is being done by the school and at their expense.
