What so many who attended our parish mission experienced over the past week must not be put aside or forgotten but can lead us onward to experience the continuing out-pouring of God's Love, Mercy, and Healing; when Jesus took the bread, blessed it and broke it and said to his disciples, "Take this, and eat of it, for this is my body." and again when he took the cup and said to his disciples, "Take this, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my blood, the blood of the new and eternal covenant, which will be poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins, do this in memory of me." and when Jesus took the bowl of water and washed the feet of his disciples and told them, "If I, then, the Lord and Master, have washed your feet, you should wash each other's feet. I have given you an example so that you may copy what I have done to you."
