From Sunday the 3 March you will notice a white board on the right hand side of the sanctuary in the church, with the heading

#### **'Please Pray For'.**

For the past nine months Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament continues in our parish on every Monday from 9am – 1pm and every Wednesday from 2pm – 8pm.

The primary purpose of this adoration is that those who participate "will intercede for the conversion of the parish and the ministry of its priest" (*Parish Constitution – The Apostolate of Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration*). As an attempt to make sure we are praying for the people in our parish and their intentions, you are invited to call to the church at your convenience any time during the week, write your personal petition or intention on the yellow note tags provided and place your tag on the white board.

During the hours of Adoration your petition or intention will be prayed for by the adorers during that week.

Then at the weekend masses the white board will be taken in procession, along with the gifts for mass, as part of the offertory.

The white board will then be cleared and replaced in the church, so new petitions and intentions can be prayed for during the coming week.
