Lent 2004

Lent is what you do.

From the earliest times the Christian Church has seen Lent as "The Great Fast". This is a time of assessment, atonement and of strengthening our will. It is a time of asking ourselves the hard questions; how am I living? where am I going? These questions need to lead to action and so we have the tradition of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Each of these is a way of reaching out to God and to our neighbour.

Lent is also the time of our Trocaire campaign. Conscious of the poverty and deprivation of others we link our fasting with contributing to their development. We become more conscious of the link between high standards of living and poverty. We look at the inequalities that are maintained by injustice.

The Lenten campaign run by Trocaire help to remind us that the need is there 365 days a year and that the development work goes on all the time. 70% of all Trocaire's general funds go to ongoing development. This is their main work, but they step in to alleviate a crisis, such as the earthquakes or famine or the genocide of Rwanda.

Trocaire Boxes are available at the Church. It is a good idea to have the box in some prominent place in the house. What is saved by the Lenten Fast could be put into the box.

On $Holy\ Thursday$, the evening on which we celebrate the $Last\ Supper$, the Boxes will be brought to the Altar at the time of the Offerings.
