Yet the ritual of consciously remembering loved ones who have passed is an important spiritual practice in all our lives. It brings death into the context of our daily experience and reminds us that dying is not the end.

This year on All Saints Day or All Souls Day, make a list of your departed loved ones bring your list to the church and place it in the basket on the sanctuary they will remain there for the month of November. At home in you own personal space, find an object or something that can be your remembrance for each of them as you go about your daily life in the month ahead. This simple spiritual practice becomes an expression of gratitude, wonder, and your continuing love for those who have gone before us.
