Until he comes again

Lent is a journey. For those coming into Christianity as adults Lent is the final journey to Baptism. During this time they prepare for their baptism at the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord on Holy Saturday Night. For those of us who are well on the road it is a journey towards the renewal of our Baptismal Promises on that same night. Lent is also a reminder that we journey towards to the Lord.

During Lent we journey in solidarity with Jesus as he goes up to Jerusalem. There he gave himself to us at the Last Supper, he gave himself for us on Calvary and he invited us to join him in Resurrection as he gives us the Life of Baptism.

The Eucharist underpins our Lenten journey. At Mass we recall the reminder of St. Paul to the people of Corinth; "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes." At the solemn point of that memorial we proclaim; "Christ has died. Christ has risen. Christ will come again." Meantime we journey on "until he comes again".

Income €132,335.13

Expenditure €147,425.97

Debit Balance over the year €15,090.84

Whereas the overall balance for the year is in the red, the actual bank balance, in February 2005, is in credit to the sum of over €42,000.00. This is due to the very generous response to the Roof Fund.

The total cost of the roof was €188,021.00, including professional fees. €68,165.00 of that cost was paid out in January 2005 and so does not show in the 2004 accounts.
