#### Families of Parishes

A little bit of light was shed on future plans for parishes, which priests and people were becoming anxious about, in a letter from Bishop Gavin to priests during the week.

For Bandon, Bantry and Ross areas, a meeting in Rosscarbery on Sunday 12th June for priests and -- from each parish -- three members of Parish Assembly or other key parish volunteers. The agenda will be:

- Context and current reality
- Trends in parish life
- A vision for the future
- Discussion and reaction.

At the end of June all priests will meet in Kinsale to look at how these proposed changes and structures will impact specifically on priests and their appointments.

Following that, Bishop hopes to meet with priests in relation to priestly appointments in the early weeks of July. These appointments will then be taken up at the beginning of September.

#### Synod: So that all may be heard

During this month of May, the Diocese of Cork and Ross is opening up ways for people to have a say and to listen and have an input into next year's Synod meeting in Rome which is called by Pope Francis.

The easiest way to find out more and to have your say is to go to [synod.corkandross.org](http://synod.corkandross.org) where an online confidential questionnaire is available to be filled in. (It'll take about 15 minutes.) It's open until May 24th. All the responses will be collated and added to the feedback from meetings being held across the diocese with randomly selected groups during May.
