John Newman Co-PP and Moderator, Canon Bernard Donovan Co-PP, Fr. Finbarr Crowley Co-PP, Fr. Jerry Cremin Co-PP and Fr. Michael Kelleher Co-PP. Fr. Bartholomew Dziedzic CC, a Polish Chaplain, resides in Bandon as does Fr. Bertie O'Mahony AP.

From this weekend, November 12th/13th, we will begin a Pilot Scheme where priests will stay in the parish where they reside for

Masses for three weekends and will travel to another parish to say Masses for two weekends. This is to ensure that all 17 weekend Masses in the Family of Parishes are celebrated.

The weekend of November 26th / 27th (First Sunday in Advent) is the first weekend this will affect Kilbrittain when Fr. Cremin will travel to say Masses in Newcestown and Farnivane and a priest from Bandon will say Masses in Kilbrittain. The second next weekend, December 10th/11th (3rd Advent), Fr. Cremin will say Masses in Kilmurry and Fr. Bernard O'Donovan from Kilmurry will say Masses in Kilbrittain.

We ask for your patience and prayerful support as we begin this new part of our parish life.
