Kilbrittain Historical Society Tour

Kilbrittain Historical Society's third outdoor event of the year takes place on the summer solstice of Wednesday 21st June. The outing is the 'Bandon River Tour.' The journey will cover the canal to Dunmanway, the Bandon River Dam that was to bring ships into town, the East Indian Mining Company at Dundaniel, the 1755 Tsunami that knocked Innishannon Bridge, Bandon's 400-

year-old flood defences, the 250th anniversary of Bandon Bridge, Baxter's Bridge Inland Causeway, Murragh and its historic tumulus grave of the legendary Fianna warrior Diarmuid, Dunmanway Castle and the interesting finds along the heart of the Bandon River such as the magnificent 10-arched Ballineen Bridge....

Members interested in going are asked to assemble at Kelleher's in Bandon at 6 pm sharp, where we will be walked by our tour guide and local Bandon historian, Mr. Liam Murphy, along the river Bandon on up into Lidl car park where we will then meet a waiting bus to continue with the tour. The whole journey including breaks for walking along the river, will be approximately 3 to 4 hours duration. The cost of the bus & tour is €15 per person. Seats will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis. It would be appreciated if people brought a Hi-Vis vest/jacket with them. Please give names to Denis O'Brien at 087-2517325.
