- In the current crisis, how have Christian families been able to carry out their vocation of passing on the faith?
- Since many children and young people no longer see their parents receive the sacraments, how can the Church provide a Christian education for them?
- What questions do divorced and remarried people pose the Church concerning the Sacraments of the Eucharist and of Reconciliation?
- What pastoral attention can be given to people who have chosen to live in same sex relationships?

All the responses will be gathered together to form the basis of the diocesan report that will go to Rome.
