Pope John Paul II will be canonised on 27th April next. He is credited with at least 2 miracles, the healing of a French nun, Sr. Marie Simon-Pierre who inexplicably recovered from Parkinson's disease in 2005. A second miracle involved a Costa Rican woman who was cured of brain aneurysm the very day of John Paul II's beatification.
