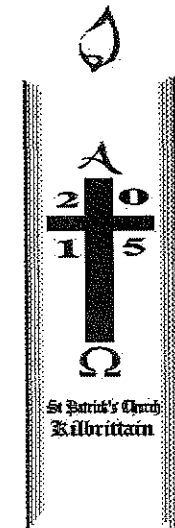
Historical Society Event
