In Today's Gospel

The foretelling of these cataclysmic events is not meant to terrify us, but to give us hope, which is summarized in St. Luke at the end of his description of the second coming, "Now when these things begin to take place, look up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." Christian believers should not be terrified but filled with hope that at last their rescue from the evil of this world is at hand.

So Christians who have true faith will not live in fear of the Second Coming and the events that will accompany it, so long as they are also ready to meet the Lord when he comes. Those who are unprepared for this judgment will understandably be terrified by the physical events, but they really should be more terrified of the spiritual event that it signals, the judgment which follows, which will reveal to all their eternal destiny.

Moreover, if I truly believe that the end of the world will come at a time that is known to no one but God, as Jesus says. Therefore, I will more likely want to be ready at all times to meet Christ. Nothing is more salutary than this intense desire to meet Christ—in this world, and in the next—and to see his creation transformed in glory, including ourselves.
