

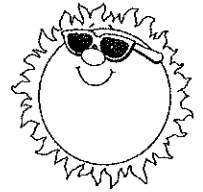

God's Design: A Wholistic View of Personhood

Underneath what the pro-life movement calls "the culture of death" is a dark, tangled mess of spiritual brokenness. The symptoms of this brokenness — whether they present as abortion, euthanasia, contraception, fractured families, human trafficking, pornography, homosexuality or gender dysphoria — reveal to us the presence of a much larger sickness and a much bigger target. They show us the tragic consequences of sin and of rejecting God's design for the human person.

God said, 'Let us make man in our own image, in the likeness of ourselves ...' God created man in the image of himself, in the image of God he created him, male and female he created them. (Genesis 1:26-28)

To destroy the human made in the image of God — to destroy inherent value, dignity and thus, personhood — the Enemy must systematically dismantle each of God's design elements — life, marriage, family, sexuality and gender. What we are witnessing everywhere in our culture today is a direct assault on these elements.
