Message from Bishop Gavin: Use of Face Coverings

In early July as we prepared for the return to public worship, parishes worked very hard to put measures in place so that people would be safe and welcome. In the meantime, parishes have continued to implement these measures including hand sanitising on entering and leaving, cleaning after each ceremony as well as assisting people to approach for Communion in a socially distanced way.

At that time in early July, the use of face coverings was strongly recommended. In light of the renewed government guidance issued last Tuesday, I would ask people to wear face coverings in

Church for all liturgical celebrations such as Mass, funerals, weddings, baptisms, confirmations and First Holy Communions etc. so that we can create as safe an environment as possible for those who come to Church and minimise the possibility of spreading the virus.

Children under 13 years of age and people who have received medical advice to not wear a mask are of course exempt.

I want to thank all those who have worked so hard to implement measures so that people may participate in Mass and public worship in a safe manner and ask your support to ensure that such measures will be implemented.
