Novena Masses

Tomorrow, Monday, is the feast of All Soul and the beginning of the Novena of Masses for the Faithful Departed. Masses every morning this week, Monday to Saturday inclusive, at 9.00 am. Livestreamed on Facebook.

Novena finishes next Tuesday week, November 10th.

Commemoration of those who have died during the last year.

We are not able to invite the recently bereaved to a special Mass as in other years. Instead we will have the usual remembrance candle for for each of the deceased with the name on a label. These will be on a table in front of the altar for the entire novena and may be taken away afterwards by family members.

Indulgences

There is no restriction on the distance one may travel in order to visit graves of loved ones. Many people will be anxious to take full advantage of this concession to compensate for not being able to attend Mass and receive Holy Communion during the Novenas. The faithful who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and* prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) and who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. ***The stipulation for Holy Communion has to be set aside and the 'Act of Contrition' will suffice instead of Confession.**
