Public Worship

From Tuesday December 1st up to 50 people can attend Mass and where the size of the church allows for a capacity greater than that number a church can be subdivided into distinct sections (pods) of not more than 50 persons in each pod. As before, 2 metre social distancing is required while members of the same household can sit together. The wearing of face coverings is expected and no gathering of people is to happen outside the church building.
